This chart rank orders counties by the overall county age-adjusted death rate. The rank is in the first column and the actual death rate in the last column. The AADR county rank order for cancer, heart disease, stroke, diabetes, homicide, suicide, accidents, and motor vehicle accidents are shown for illustrative purposes. Blank cells indicate too few deaths to provide a proper rate.

READING THE CHART

Adair county (population 21,614) has the worst death rate (1,149.7) for Oklahoma's 77 counties. It ranked 63rd, 65th, 77th and 57th for income, poverty, life expectancy and infant mortality respectively. The rankings for the various causes of death are also shown. In every case the cells are RED – indicating rates worse than the state and national rates.
