Fees listed in the Semester Fees column are charged the listed amount for the term of enrollment. At the time of this estimate, the total fee amount assessed by semester is \$463.25 for spring and fall and \$356.65 for summer. Fees listed in the Credit Hour column are assessed according to the number of credit hours taken. Total amount for credit hour fees is \$51.20 (per credit hour.) For an enrollment of 9 hours, fees assessed by credit hour would be \$460.80.
