Master of Public Health in Health Promotion

This dual degree in social work and public health involves the Master of Social Work (MSW) degree from the University of Oklahoma School of Social Work and the Master of Public Health (MPH) in Health Promotion degree from the University of Oklahoma College of Public Health. The MPH degree requires a minimum of 44 semester credit hours, including 37 credit hours of prescribed course work from the College of Public Health and at least 7 credit hours of approved electives from either the College of Public Health or the School of Social Work. These electives are selected by the student with the approval of the faculty advisor. Students must complete a Practicum in a public health setting and perform satisfactorily on the MPH culminating experience examination at the end of the MPH program.
