Master of Public Health in General Public Health

- The 6 core courses - 18 credit hours
- Selective courses - 15 credit hours
- Elective courses - 9 credit hours
- Public Health Practicum - 2 credit hours Clock hours for the Practicum are calculated at 80 hours per credit hour, or a total of 160 hours.

Students should complete the 6 core courses within the first 22 hours of enrollment.
