

Programmatic Competencies for the MPH in Health Administration and Policy

In addition to the overall Master of Public Health degree core competencies, a graduate of the Master of Public Health in Health Administration and Policy graduates should be able to:

- Use the principles of the legislative and regulatory processes to develop, implement, evaluate and manage health programs;
- Relate the structural and behavioral attributes of health organizations and their environment to the management of health programs;
- Assess the legal dimensions of existing or proposed programs
- Assess the economic dimensions of health programs or health providers;
- Develop projections and depict the financial consequences of maintaining existing programs or adopting proposed programs;
- Integrate the curriculum and apply concepts of methods in the process of developing, implementing and evaluating health programs.
